### Description

The historic Horizon Hotel is a world-class hotel in sunny Palm Springs, California. Its low-slung, angular architecture — iconic mid-century modern style — was originally designed by renowned architect William Cody in 1952, and recently renovated with the utmost care and attention to detail. The hotel's 22 beautifully-appointed rooms (including a three-bedroom residence) are the perfect setting for a secluded getaway — where the Horizon's staff will attend to your every need. And, with its combination of stunning architecture, beautiful surroundings, and impeccable service, the Horizon is an ideal choice for events and gatherings for up to 100 people.

### Location

The Horizon Hotel is located south of downtown Palm Springs, just minutes away from shopping, dining, entertainment, and nightlife, and less than 10 minutes from Palm Springs International Airport.

### History

Originally called L'Horizon, the Horizon Hotel is one of the few remaining mid-century modern hotels in Palm Springs. The Horizon was originally designed in 1952 by well-known architect William Cody for Hollywood mogul Jack Wrather and his actress wife, Bonita "Bunny" Granville, as a retreat for their family and Hollywood friends. In February 2004, Dave Scharf, a real estate developer from Portland, Oregon, purchased the hotel with a mission to revive the property's original character. To ensure the project was in keeping with Cody's original vision, architect and former Cody associate Frank Urrutia was commissioned to oversee the renovation. In May 2006, the 22-room hotel once again opened its doors to guests in search of a sophisticated desert getaway.
